


# Practice IELTS Task 2 Question

# Your Essay Plan

1. Introduction
1. Main idea
1. Thesis statement: says what your essay will do.
2. Paragraph 1
2. First reason for your opinion
3. Paragraph 2
3. Second reason for your opinion
4. Conclusion
4. Repeat the question and reasons (paragraphs 1-2)

# Simple Band 4–5 Plan (Using the 4–Paragraph Guide)

To keep it simple, let's take a clear stance: Agreeing that practical subjects are important.

## P1: Introduction (Main idea + Thesis)

- Main idea: state what the current situation is in schools. Which subjects are important? Who are they important to?
- Thesis: State clearly that you agree that practical skills are important for students' future.

## P2: Body 1 (Main Idea 1: Practical Skills)

- Topic Sentence: Start with a clear idea. Example: Learning practical skills helps students manage their lives well.
- Reason: Explain why. Example: Cooking and budgeting are needed every day.
- Example: Give a simple example. Example: A student who learns cooking can make healthy food and save money.

## P3: Body 2 (Main Idea 2: Academic Subjects)

- Topic Sentence: Although practical skills are good, academic subjects are still necessary.
- Reason: Explain why. Example: Math and science help students find good jobs in the future.
- Example: Give a simple example. Example: Doctors need to study science, and accountants must be good at math.

## P4: Conclusion (Summary + Final Opinion)

- Summary: Briefly repeat the two points (practical skills help daily life, but academic skills help careers).
- Final Opinion: Restate your belief that both types of subjects are necessary for success.

# Model Essay.

## Practical vs. Academic Subjects in Schools

In recent times, there has been a growing demand for schools to prepare young people better for the practical challenges of independent adult life. This essay will argue that practical subjects are the most important for preparing students for their adult lives.

The primary reason why schools must include practical subjects is that these skills help students manage their everyday adult lives. When a student finishes school, they immediately need to know how to live independently. If they do not learn life skills, they can face problems like debt or poor health. 
